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## Allendale East OSHC Service

### OUR OSHC CENTRE IS AT RISK OF CLOSURE

We rely on a Government Grant to help with the costs associated with running our programs in a small centre. Unfortunately this year we have not received our Grant money for Afterschool Care as we haven't met the minimum requirements of students in attendance and days open. For us to receive this Grant we need to have a minimum of 3 students every day of the week.

You are entitled to a rebate through the CCB (Child Care Benefit) and this is deducted from your account prior to an invoice being sent out. The rebate is reflective of your income and our (computer) system is linked to Family Assistance Office which automatically works this out for us. Families must provide their CRN's (Customer Reference Numbers) on enrolment forms to be able to receive CCB in the form of reduced fees.

Afterschool OSHC we offer for the first hour at a reduced rate of \$10 as well as full session 3:15pm to 6pm at \$16. We are open every weekday but currently we only have bookings for Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. We desperately need bookings for everyday of the week to make the service viable. All bookings need to be made prior to the day required and need to be made through our OSHC Director.
